

EVENT SANCTIONING AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made and entered into this ____ day of _____ by and

between the Malta Boxing Commission ("MBC") and ______

_____ ("PROMOTER").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, MBC is a recognized and legal sanctioning body; and

WHEREAS, PROMOTER is a recognized and licensed promoter in the Country of _____; and

WHEREAS, MBC and PROMOTER desire to enter into Agreement to affect the following defined Event.

THEN, THEREFORE, in consideration the **MBC** grants to **PROMOTER** sanctioning rights for a professional boxing event which

will take place at _____

The weigh-ins and a rules meeting for the participants of the Event will be held on the _____ of

and shall be in accordance with unified rules of professional boxing.

2. **MBC** grants to the **PROMOTER** all promotional rights for the Event, including all local sponsorship income. **PROMOTER** may, at its discretion, utilize the **MBC** name, logo, sanctioning certificate and ratings (the "Rights"), but only as relates specifically to Event. **PROMOTER** shall safeguard, protect and defend the Rights against all third-party uses and hereby states that it claims no right, title or interest therein, beyond the license granted herein.

3. The **PROMOTER** will receive all revenues derived from the promotion of the event including but not limited to: ticket sales, program advertising, ring mat and corner post advertising, venue advertising, food and beverage profit (if applicable).

4. The **MBC** shall furnish the **PROMOTER** official **MBC** rules which shall be used during the Event and for all matters related thereto.

5. An **MBC** official will explain the **MBC** rules to the Event officials, judges, managers and fighters prior to the sanctioned Event and provide consultation concerning the **MBC** rules prior to the Event on a reasonable, as needed, basis.

6. **MBC** shall certify all officials including judges, referees, and timekeepers, which shall be supplied and paid for by the **PROMOTER**. Should the **PROMOTER** provide written notice to the **MBC** thirty (30) days prior to the Event, of the intention to employ local qualified officials, that **PROMOTOR** agrees that the said named officials information will be provided no later than seven (7) days prior to the event for verification of qualifications.

7. **MBC** will provide a minimum of **one (1)** official to the Event as supervisor ("**Supervisor**") to oversee and officiate the Event. The **Supervisor** will receive four hundred euros (\notin 400) as compensation for this duty.

8. As the boxing commission that has jurisdiction of the Event the **MBC** shall have final approval of the officials for the Event, including those that are licensed by other organisations.

9. Compensation for **MBC** provided officials are listed below

Supervisor:	€400
Inspector:	€200
Referees	€400
Judges	€200
Timekeeper	€350
Doctors	€475*
*Doctors fee	may vary either up or down dependent on location of event.

For events with more than five (5) professional bouts two doctors are mandatory

10. The **PROMOTER** is responsible for all expenses including travel, hotel accommodations and food associated with the **MBC** supervisor, inspectors judges, referees, and timekeepers involved in Event.

11. The MBC Event Sanctioning fees are as follows

1-5 Bouts	€350
6-10 Bouts	€550

10 Plus Bouts €700

PLEASE NOTE: For televised events or those featuring Championship bouts an additional fee of 2% of gate revenue is payable.

12. The **PROMOTER** shall provide gloves and all other equipment necessary for all **MBC** sanctioned bouts and the Event.

The weight of gloves to be used in MBC Sanctioned contests shall be as follows:

a) Super Welterweight, up to and including Heavyweights, shall use ten (10) ounce gloves.

b) Light Flyweight, up to and including Welterweight, shall use eight (8) ounce gloves.

The **MBC** inspector shall inspect the gloves of each contestant prior to the beginning of the contest to insure that the gloves are free of any foreign substance that could be detrimental to an opponent, and are properly laced and taped.

13. The amount and type of hand wraps to be used in **MBC** Sanctioned contests shall be as follows:

a) In all weight classes, hand wraps shall be restricted to thirty (30) yards of soft gauze not more than two (2) inches in width, held in place by not more than eight (8) feet of adhesive tape, one and one half $(1 \frac{1}{2})$ inches in width, for each hand.

b) Adhesive tape shall not cover any part of the knuckles when the hand is clenched to make a fist.

The MBC Inspector shall inspect the bandages to insure that they comply with these and all local regulations.

14. The **MBC** inspector shall verify before the contest that ring used for the contests shall be no less than eighteen (18) feet (5,486m) nor more than twenty-four (24) feet (7,315m) by side within the ropes.

15. All contestants are required to wear a mouthpiece during competition. No bout may commence unless each contestant has a back-up mouthpiece in the corner. The round cannot begin without a mouthpiece in place. If the mouthpiece is dislodged during competition, the referee will call time and replace the mouthpiece at the first opportune moment without interfering with the immediate action. Points may be deducted by the referee if he feels the mouthpiece is being purposely spit out.

16. The **MINIMUM** medical coverage required for events sanctioned by the **MBC**

Events featuring up to five (5) bouts

Equipped Medical Room including defibrillator

One Doctor

Two Paramedics

One Emergency Equipped Ambulance

Please note: though the above is the minimum standard, we do recommend that a second doctor to be on standby at the venue at all times.

Events featuring more than five (5) bouts but no more than ten bouts (10)

Equipped Medical Room including defibrillator

Two Doctors

Two Paramedics

One Emergency Equipped Ambulance

Please note: though the above is the minimum standard, we do advise that a third doctor and a second ambulance and paramedic team to be on standby at the venue at all times.

Events featuring more than ten (10) bouts, or Championship events

Equipped Medical Room including defibrillator

Two Doctors

Four Paramedics

Two Emergency Equipped Ambulances

Please note: That it is a requirement of the MBC that the one of the doctors should be either an Emergency Response Trauma Specialist, Neurologist or anaesthetist.

17. The **PROMOTER** and the participating fighters in the Event and any fighter in any **MBC** sanctioned event must be approved members in good standing with the **MBC** prior to the official weigh-in and by signing this Agreement, also gives consent to submit, if required, to a pre-orpost fight urine test to detect banned substances in their respective bodies.

18. **PROMOTER** and **MBC** further agree that

(a) This Agreement may not assigned by either party without the prior written consent of the other party. Subject to the foregoing limitation, this Agreement shall inure to the benefit of and be binding on the successors and assigns of the respective parties.

- (b) This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Republic of Malta. Any matter related to the enforcement or interpretation of this Agreement shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts having jurisdiction over the Republic of Malta and the parties hereto submit to the personal jurisdiction and venue of such courts.
- (c) If any legal action is necessary to enforce the terms of this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to reasonable attorney's fees in addition to any other relief to which that party may be entitled.
- (d) This Agreement sets forth the entire agreement between the parties with regard to the subject matter of this agreement. No other agreements, representations, or warranties have been made by either party to the other with respect to the subject matter of this Agreement.
- (e) There is no third party beneficiary intended under this agreement.
- (f) This Agreement has been reviewed, negotiated and developed by the parties and their counsel. No rule of construction establishing any presumption of interpretation for against any party shall be applied or considered.

19. SPECIAL STIPULATIONS; MBC allows the PROMOTOR to use local officials with the exception of the MBC Supervisor.
